1. that Ridings Mobility LTD provided a playground safety inspection for the Cridling Stubbs play park.
2. that the report provided information that the play park was a clean site and all playground equipment was in good working order.
3. that the Cridling Stubbs playground gate requires adjusting.

54. **GRASS CUTTING**

RESOLVED

1. that Mr James Capon provides Cridling Stubbs Parish Council grass services in 2019.
2. that Mr James Capon is to provide two grass cuts every month at a price of £120.00.

55. **PAYSCALE**

RESOLVED

1. that Mr Carl Hughes, Clerk to the Council salary is to increase from £9.27 per hour to £12.64 per hour.

56. **CRIDLING STUBBS VILLAGE HALL COMMITTEE**

RESOLVED to be noted,

1. that the Village Hall coffee morning is attracting local residents.
2. that entertainment such as race nights are provided on an evening for the community.

57. **VILLAGE HALL NOTICE BOARD**

RESOLVED

1. that the Cridling Stubbs Parish Council will purchase a notice board for the community.
2. that Mr Carl Hughes, Clerk to the Council is to provide members with quotations for the installation of a new notice board.

58. **GALE COMMON EXTRACTION PROJECT**

RESOLVED that Cridling Subbs Parish Council's expressed concerns of the Gale Common Project be noted,

1. Impact on air quality, pollution and noise.
2. Visual impact.
3. Road infrastructure

59. **GALE COMMON EXTRACTION PROJECT**

RESOLVED that that EP provided Council members and the public with the following point to be noted,

1. that 1 million tons of ash to be removed a year for 25 years.
2. that a dust management plan will be provided in the planning application.
3. that dust monitors would be placed around the site.
4. that traffic dust will be controlled by keeping the material moist.
5. that traffic on the roads will be limited from 7am until 7pm.
6. that a noise assessment will be in place taking the baseline to 10% of it surrounding area.
7. that Air Quality will be constantly monitored.
8. that transport will turn right from the Gale Common Project site towards the M62, avoiding Cridling Stubbs. However, occasionally transport could turn left.

9. that members of the public expressed concern of the size of the road with no public footpaths.

10. that EP could widen the roads or regularly cut the grass verges.

11. that EP could lower the speed limit from the Gale Common site to the M62 motorway

12. that work will not be carried out on the sites hill top. Consequently, the site should not have a visual impact on the community.

13. that the site will be left flat on completion.

60. **MEMBERS ITEMS**

RESOLVED

1. that Cridling Stubbs Parish Council is not to pay the same as Womersley Parish Council for the maintenance of the joint burial ground.
